**PNBAC1 RESOLUTION No. 017-2020**

**Resolution Declaring GOLD WINGS AVIATION as the Winning Bidder for the project  
“Repair and Refurbishment of NV310” and Recommending Approval of the NOA**

**WHEREAS**, the Philippine Navy thru the Philippine Navy Bids and Awards Committee1 caused the advertisement of the Invitation to Bid (ITB) for the project “**Repair and Refurbishment of NV310**” at the Philippine Government Electronic Procurement System Website (PhilGEPS) on 26 January 2020. Likewise, it was posted at conspicuous places within the premises of the PNBAC Office continuously for seven (7) calendar days;

**WHEREAS**, the PNBAC1 conducted public bidding on 180900H February 2020 at the PNBAC Conference Room, Naval Station Jose Francisco, Fort Bonifacio, Taguig City wherein two (2) bidders submitted the required Eligibility, Technical and Financial Proposals of the bid. Both were rated “**PASSED**” and subsequently declared as “eligible” bidders;

**WHEREAS**, after a detailed evaluation of the financial proposals submitted by eligible bidders, the PNBAC1 found both the proposals compliant as to form and within the ABC of the project. Furthermore, the proposal of **GOLD WINGS AVIATION** was calculated to be the lowest. Thus, it was declared the “**Lowest Calculated Bid**” subject to post qualification, to wit:

After thorough verification, validation and ascertaining all the statements made and documents submitted by the bidder, the Post Qualification Team found and established the bid to be “**Responsive**” to the requirements of the project;

**NOW, THEREFORE**, for and in consideration of the foregoing, **We**, the **Members of the Philippine Navy Bids and Awards Committee<sup>1</sup>**, by virtue of the powers vested on **Us** by law, hereby **RESOLVE** as it is hereby **RESOLVED** the following:

- a. To declare the bid of **GOLD WINGS AVIATION** as the **Lowest Calculated Responsive Bid** for the project **“Repair and Refurbishment of NV310”**.
- b. To recommend for the Approval of the **Flag Officer In Command, Philippine Navy** of the corresponding **Notice of Award**.


