

Bid Data Sheet; ITB Clause 5.3:</b></p> <p><b>a.</b> For this purpose, similar contracts shall refer to Supply and Delivery of Logistical Requirements/Supply and Delivery of Appurtenances.</p> <p>Will our completed project titled” Supply and Delivery of 72-100RF Supplies for PN Units (Lot 8- General Other Supplies)” suffice for the requirements as Supply and Delivery of Logistical Requirements? <b>Please take note that the particular item included in our completed project was 8D batteries.</b></p> <p>We have another project and the entire project was “Supply and Installation of Air Conditioning Units” will the PMCBAC consider this for the Single Largest Completed Contract which is similar to the contract to be bid.</p>	<p><b>Request Denied-</b> the BAC cannot consider the completed project (Supply and Delivery of 72-100 RF Supplies for PN units (Lot 8- General Other Supplies/8D batteries as similar contract contemplated in ITB Clause 5.3.</p> <p><b>Request Granted-</b> the BAC consider the project “Supply and Installation of Air Conditioning Units” as similar to the contract to be bid.</p>

Bid Data Sheet; ITB Clause 5.3:</b></p> <p><b>b.</b> The bidder must submit a statement of a single, largest completed contract that is similar to the contract to be bid and whose value, adjusted to current prices using the consumer price indices of the NSO available at the G-EPS website, of <b>at least 50%</b> of the ABC undertaken for the past Five (5) years prior to the deadline of the submission and receipt of bids.</p> <p>We would like to request to reduce the percentage amount of SLCC to at least 25% of the ABC.</p>	<p><b>Request Denied-</b> Section II Instruction to Bidders 5.3 stated that Pursuant to Section 23.4.1.3 of the 2016 revised IRR of RA No.9184, the Bidder shall have an SLCC that is at least one (1) contract similar to the Project the value of which, adjusted to current prices using the PSA's CPI, must be at least equivalent to:</p> <p>For the procurement of <b>Non-Expendable Supplies:</b> The Bidder must have completed a single contract that is similar to this Project, equivalent to <b>at least Fifty percent (50%)</b> of the ABC.</p> <p>a. Appurtenances are considered as <b>NON EXPENDABLES Supplies.</b></p> <p>b. The Phrase "<b>at least 50%</b> of the ABC must be interpreted to mean "<b>not less than</b>" the required value which is 50% of the ABC.</p>
