

**CONTRACT AGREEMENT
(302CO-GSM-074-23)**

THIS AGREEMENT made this _____ between Philippine Navy, Armed Forces of the Philippines (hereinafter called "the Entity") of the one part and Petron Corporation of 40 Ground Floor, San Miguel Head Office Complex, San Miguel Ave. Wack-Wack Greenhills, Mandaluyong (hereinafter called "the Supplier") of the other part;

WHEREAS, the Entity invited Bids for certain goods and ancillary services, particularly Supply and Delivery of Industrial Petroleum, Oil and Lubricant (POL) Products (4th Wave) and has accepted a Bid by the Supplier for the supply of those goods and services in the sum of TWO HUNDRED EIGHTEEN MILLION THREE HUNDRED FIFTY-SIX THOUSAND ONE HUNDRED SEVENTY-FIVE PESOS AND 98/100 (PhP218,356,175.98) (hereinafter called "the Contract Price").

WHEREAS, based on the executed Certificate of Undertaking an equivalent value and/or volume of THIRTY-ONE MILLION SIX HUNDRED FORTY-THREE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED TWENTY-FOUR PESOS AND 02/100 (PhP31,643,824.02) of diesel premium (POL) product will be delivered in Cavite City Base on the actual pricing, over and above the price quotation offered.

NOW THIS AGREEMENT WITNESSETH AS FOLLOWS:

1. In this Agreement words and expressions shall have the same meanings as are respectively assigned to them in the Conditions of Contract referred to.
2. The following documents as required by the 2016 revised Implementing Rules and Regulations of Republic Act No. 9184 shall be deemed to form and be read and construed as integral part of this Agreement, viz.:
 - i. Philippine Bidding Documents (PBDs);
 - i. Schedule of Requirements;
 - ii. Technical Specifications;
 - iii. General and Special Conditions of Contract; and
 - iv. Supplemental or Bid Bulletins, if any
 - v. Notarized Certificate of Undertaking
 - ii. Winning bidder's bid, including the Eligibility requirements, Technical and Financial Proposals, and all other documents or statements submitted;

Bid form, including all the documents/statements contained in the Bidder's bidding envelopes, as annexes, and all other documents submitted (e.g., Bidder's response to request for clarifications on the bid), including corrections to the bid, if any, resulting from the Procuring Entity's bid evaluation;

- iii. Performance Security;
- iv. Notice of Award of Contract; and the Bidder's conforme thereto; and
- v. Other contract documents that may be required by existing laws and/or the Procuring Entity concerned in the PBDs. Winning bidder agrees that additional contract documents or information prescribed by the GPPB that are subsequently required for submission after the contract execution, such as the Notice to Proceed, Variation Orders, and Warranty Security, shall likewise form part of the Contract.

3. In consideration for the sum of **TWO HUNDRED FIFTY MILLION PESOS ONLY (PhP250,000,000.00)** or such other sums as may be ascertained, **Petron Corporation** agrees to **Supply and Delivery of Industrial Petroleum, Oil and Lubricant (POL) Products (4th Wave)** in accordance with his/her/its Bid.
4. **The Philippine Navy, Armed Forces of the Philippines** agrees to pay the above-mentioned sum in accordance with the terms of the Bidding.
5. The Parties shall comply with the applicable provision of the Data Privacy Act of 2012, also known as Republic Act No. 10173, its IRR, the issuances and circulars of the National Privacy Commission (NPC), as well as other applicable personal data privacy and protection laws and regulations (collectively, "Privacy Laws") subject to the provisions of RA No. 9184 as well as all relevant GPPB and Department of Budget and Management (DBM) issuances.
