Nr	Clarifications	Response
1	Would you require bidders to submit a certificate of sample verification?	The certificate of sample verification is not required since the GOODS are new in the PMCs inventory which means the prospective bidder has no item to be verified. Therefore, the issuance of the certificate of sample verification does not apply to the project.
2	Would you require the bidders to submit at least one customer satisfaction certificate?	The BAC will not require the prospective bidder to submit a customer satisfaction certificate for the project.
3	The tender requires a Heavy-duty Bed with Load Capacity of 240kg/529 lbs Question: Would you allow the load capacity of the COT BED (150kgs/ 330 lbs.)?	The BAC encourages the prospective bidder to comply with the loading capacity of the COT BED as required in the technical specifications. The rationale for the higher loading capacity is as follows: 1. can withstand pulling forces or high levels of stress; 2. higher the tensile strength, the stronger the material/ product; and 3. Safe, reliable to use, and durable (Heavy-Duty).
