Supplemental/Bid Bulletin No.1

Supply and Delivery of Labor and Materials for the Repair of Amphibious Assault Vehicles (AAVs) of PMC
with an ABC of **Thirty-Nine Million Two Hundred Thousand Pesos (PhP39,200,000.00)**

This Supplemental/Bid Bulletin is issued to inform prospective bidders the modifications/amendments that shall form part of the bidding documents for the project: **Supply and Delivery of Labor and Materials for the Repair of Amphibious Assault Vehicles (AAVs) (MR-PMCBAC-2024-07)** to wit:

A. Answer to Queries:

<p>A. Section V. Special Condition Item NR 18:</p> <p>The contractor shall request for a Quality and Reliable Assurance (QRA) inspection upon delivery /installation of the parts in the technical specifications to the concerned Contracting Office.</p> <p>Question: Can we request more detailed scope and guidelines for the QRA? Additionally, is this an end user inspection, and how does it differ from the assessment and inspection conducted by the Technical Inspection and Acceptance Committee (TIAC).</p>	<p>The QRA will inspect the delivered components/parts prior to its installation to confirm adherence to the technical specifications (Part Number/Serial Number/ Description), while the TIAC inspection will evaluate the functionality and operational efficiency of the AAV. This is not an end user inspection.</p>

B. Section VI-Schedule of Requirement:

Within One Hundred Eighty (180) Calendar Days upon receipt of Notice to Proceed (NTP).

Question: Can the delivery period commence after the full turnover of vehicles to the winning bidder, supplier, dealer, or service provider, rather than starting from date of the Notice to Proceed (NTP)? In some cases, a project lot included multiple vehicles and there were instances where one or more vehicle have not yet been turned over to the winning bidder, supplier, dealer or service provider on or shortly after the NTP is issued.

The request for the change of the delivery period to commence after the full turnover of the vehicles to the winning bidder, supplier, dealer, or service provider rather than starting from date of the NTP is **DENIED**.

The delivery period is within One Hundred Eighty (180) calendar days from the receipt of the Notice to Proceed (NTP). As specified in the bidding document, the winning bidder is responsible for transporting the vehicle to the project site.

Therefore, the arrival of the vehicles to the project site on or before the issuance of NTP for the commencement of the project is highly dependent on the timely transport of the vehicles by the winning bidder.

Hence, the delivery period remains “*within one hundred eighty (180) calendar days from the receipt of the Notice to Proceed (NTP)*”.

C. Technical and Acceptance Procedure (TAP):

In relation to the Scope of Work or Schedule of Requirement, the bidding documents does not include the Technical and Acceptance Procedure.

Question: Can we request for the required Technical and Acceptance Procedure in relation to the Scope of Work?

The parameters for the TIAC will be included in the SBB as per AAVs Technical Manual (Road and Water Test Drive Parameter).
