d.2 Warranty Certificate for the Light Machine Gun, 5.56mm and Optic Sight for a period of two (2) years to be reckoned after the date of final acceptance.

d.3 Manufacturer's Certificate for the availability of spare parts, service or any support for the maintenance of the Light Machine Gun, 5.56mm: Squad Automatic Weapon for the next twenty (20) years which will begin upon termination of the given warranty period.

d.4 Certification that the Manufacturer must have manufactured and delivered firearms for the last 5 years and have passed any endurance and functional testing conducted.

d.5 Certification indicating the Light Machine Gun/ Squad Automatic Weapon is coming from one (1) manufacturer only.

d.6 Certification indicating the Optic/Reflex Sight is coming from one (1) manufacturer only.

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d.7 Certification of Chemical Analysis of the barrel

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d.8 Certification that the bidder is the manufacturer of the items to be procured.
