1	<p>Our company attended the pre-bid conference for the above project and it was observed that line-item No. 26 Diazepam, 5mg/2ml 30 Ampoule is included in the list of items to be procured. However, I would like to clarify and call to attention of the offices concerned regarding the existing rules set forth by the Dangerous Drugs Board pertaining to possession/dispensation of regulated drugs to wit:</p> <p style="text-align: center;">BOARD REGULATION No. 1 Series of 2014</p> <p><i>Subject: Comprehensive Amendments to Board Regulation No. 3 Series 2003, "Comprehensive Guidelines on Importation, Distribution, Manufacture, Prescription, Dispensing, Controlled Precursors and Essentials Chemicals and other Similar or Analogous Substance", as Amended, and Other Related Board Issuances.</i></p> <p>Pursuant to Section 2, Section 12, 16, and 32, of Article II, Section 40 of Article III, Section 81(b) and (r) of Article IX and Section 93 of Article XI of RA 9165, the following guidelines are hereby promulgated:</p>	<p>Denied. Diazepam is a critically important emergency medicine for MBGL Medical Dispensary and the PMC Modular Healthcare Facility particularly in emergencies involving patients with seizures. Moreover, it shall only be prescribed by a Medical Officer with an S2 License. By ensuring the availability of this life-saving drug in our facilities, we will be able to manage emergencies effectively, prevent potentially life-threatening complications, improve patient outcomes, and ultimately save lives. Hence, the end-user cannot omit this drug from the list of line items.</p> <p>The end-user may assist the winning bidder in obtaining prescription pads as needed, provided that the cost of the prescription pads will be covered by the winning bidder.</p>

Possession or Use of Regulated Drugs. The penalty of imprisonment ranging from six months and one day to four years and a fine ranging from six thousand to four thousand pesos shall be imposed upon any person who shall possess or use any regulated drug without the corresponding license or prescription.

Included in this board regulation are the corresponding licenses required for every individual who will possess this regulated drug

1. The Pharmacist	(S2)	S2 holder pharmacist of PMC dispensary
2. The Rental distributor/dispenser	(S3)	PMC dispensary office
3. Wholesaler/distributor	(S4)	Bidder/.Offeror


Requisition of the above regulated drugs require that these licenses must be present for the offices and personality in this bid aside of the submission and monitoring of reports for the PDEA. Hence, we humbly suggest that this regulated drug be omitted in the list and be coursed thru military hospitals instead. It, being small quantity compared to the sixty-six-line item in the bid document.
